Bio and Performance Record	<p>Davidor is the black Hanoverian stallion by Davignon out of Wanessa (Warkant/Eiger). He is a proven FEI stallion, having shown successfully through Intermediare in Germany.</p> <p>Davidor offers a top notch pedigree. His sire, Davignon I, is generally considered to be one of Donnerhall's best sons, having earned Class I scores at his licensing in 1991 before going on to win the Bundeschampionat in 1992. Davignon is also noted as an outstanding sire having sired over 20 approved sons to date, including FEI stallions Davignport and Dacaprio. Davidor's damsire, Warkant, is by World Cup I, who also sired the famous Weltmeyer. Like Davignon I, Warkant earned Class I scores at his performance testing and is the sire of numerous approved sons, as well as top competition horses such as Hubertus Schmidt's Olympic mount, Wansuela Suerte.</p> <p>Davidor's dam, Wanessa, is a proven producer and a Bundeschampionat winner as well. She has consistently been represented at stallion licensings by her sons and produced mares of top quality.</p> <p>In Davidor's 3rd generation, we find Eiger I, patriarch of Hanoverian show jumping stallions such as Espri, Escudo I /II, El Bundy, etc.</p> <p>Davidor's breeding index is 132/83% for dressage production in Germany. He has been represented 3 times by his daughters at the Bundeschampionat since 2000 and they have placed well. Making him a fine option for those wanting to breed solid competition mounts with solid a pedigree.</p>
